



Stolfe's Portside Percussion Studio Success Guide

My goal is for each student to attain success with each lesson in an enjoyable and educational format. Drumming is an incredibly FUN and rewarding activity! It also requires hard work, commitment, and consistent effort. With these elements, drumming will be even more FUN!!!

The intent for this success guide is to provide a framework for each student, and to provide guidelines and general studio policies for students, and parents/guardians. Where required, this guide provides Stolfe's Portside Percussion Studio (Studio) with your authorization and acknowledgement of terms of service.

Practice Expectations

Yes, I do expect all students to PRACTICE! However, I do not define practice as a few minutes of practice crammed in prior to a lesson! We've all tried...it just doesn't work!

Early on, I present a structured method for each student to practice the materials we are working on. Practice assignments are given with the expectation that students will practice **consistently** during the week, at least 3-4 days per week. **Minimum** expectations *per percussion instrument studied* are as follows:

- 5-10 minutes warm-up/scales/rudiments
- 10 minutes etudes/solos
- 5-10 minutes assigned exercises in books
- 5-10 minutes sight reading (or additional technique/solo work)

Equipment & Materials to obtain

All percussionists and drummers should always be equipped with the proper tools for the job. Minimally, each student should own the following:

Sticks (5A or 5B) for drum set (optional concert Snare Drumsticks)
Stick Bag (recommended)
Bell/Marimba/Xylophone Mallets (grade school/middle/high school students only)
Music Notebook with staff paper & Pencils
Method Books /Solo music (I will let you know as these are needed)
Music Stand (kept at home)
Metronome (kept at home)
3-ring binder with clear plastic inserts for handouts and copied exercises
Ear protection (ask for recommendations)

As I typically wait one year (minimally) with beginning students before I teach drum set, do not give in to the temptation to rush out and buy a drum set prematurely. Please ask me if you have any questions regarding this. For the serious percussion student, it is more important to own/rent the following before a drum set:

Snare Drum
Practice Pad
Bell Kit or Student Xylophone

Tuition (Updated and Effective January 2023)

- Tuition for lessons is billed/paid for **monthly**, by the **first** lesson of each month. Invoices will be sent out prior to the first lesson of the month. Invoices may be paid online via provided link or in person. Other accepted payment methods are cash, credit/debit card or check payable to "Stolfe's Portside Percussion Studio."
- Lesson fees are the following:
 - \$100/month – 30 minutes
 - \$200/month – 60 minutes
 - Ensemble Classes will be billed the determined rate prior to the first class, and payments are due at the first class.
 - Any teacher cancelled lesson will be made up or credited at my discretion.
 - Failure to pay may result in forfeiture of scheduled lesson time. Excessive late payments past the 15th of the month may incur a \$15.00 late fee.
 - If a student discontinues lessons for any reason, advanced lesson payment will not be reimbursed.

Lesson Attendance

Consistent lesson attendance is critical for student success and progress. Most percussion studios and music lesson studios rarely allow for make-up lessons. Therefore, it is imperative that students and parents make lessons a priority in their schedules.

I do realize that serious, irresolvable conflicts do arise on rare occasions. Therefore, please use the following as a guide for excused cancellations. These are the only excused absences that can be made up:

- Student illness or family emergency – when possible, please notify me by **10:00am on the day of the lesson.**
- Pre-planned vacations (please provide at least 7 days' notice when possible.)
- Lessons scheduled during some holidays may be rescheduled without penalty for absences.
- Lack of preparation for a lesson or busy schedules **are not** suitable reasons for excused absences.
- Make up lessons will be offered based on my schedule availability.
- Lessons requiring rescheduling for reasons other than excused absences, should be requested with at least 7 days' notice. Rescheduling done with proper notice should be scheduled by contacting me directly. When possible, based on my schedule availability an alternate lesson time may be offered.
